## SAN ANGELO OFFERS OPPORTUNITY

The 2015 show season is in full swing. We've got 2 full shows behind us in Abilene and Lubbock, as well a collegiate show at the Star of Texas Fair in Austin. Thanks to everyone who has helped, managed and volunteered to make our shows a great success.

The San Angelo show will offer riders a new opportunity to compete in the AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse (VRH) events. We've co-approved shows before, but this show will be the first under AQHA's new VRH rules for the Ranching Division.

Some may wonder why SHOT offers these co-approved shows. Several of our members enjoy showing under both SHOT and AQHA. We have worked closely with AQHA for the last several months to develop a system where SHOT exhibitors can ride for SHOT and AQHA points simultaneously. This will not only add to your year-end SHOT standings and awards, but also include AQHA points that go on your horse's permanent show record with AQHA. Showing in AQHA VRH could qualify you and your horse to compete at the AQHA Versatility World Show.

There are still a few details that need to be smoothed out to make a co-approved show seamless for all riders, and we will be working with AQHA in the coming months toward that goal for 2016.

We have worked hard to keep the best interest of the SHOT membership in mind, and are offering AQHA Versatility classes as a benefit for our membership. We know showing horses is expensive, and by offering co-approved shows, you can ride in both SHOT and AQHA without the cost of traveling to 2 different shows, paying 2 different stall and hotel/RV fees. Of course, if you just want to show in SHOT classes, that's great! There's no pressure to enter AQHA events.

From time to time, you may see some fresh faces who come to our shows initially to compete in just AQHA. But we hope that our friendliness and willingness to help our fellow riders will draw these exhibitors into the SHOT family as well.
