
Record-Breaking Turnout in Abilene

Combining traditional western and classical horsemanship, Jack absolutely wowed the audience with fluid shifts from dressage maneuvers to reining maneuvers on the same horse. After the clinic, folks had a chance to grab a seat and enjoy a hamburger dinner provided by Total Equine just in time to watch 23 entries in the jackpot cutting.
