#### FULL SPEED INTO FALL

It seems just a couple of months ago that we were planning the 2021 season. And now we just have a few events left to wrap up the year. It's been such a fun year of friendships, fellowship and growth for SHTX.

September is a BUSY month for us with the Hamilton and Bryan shows. Also mark your calendars for Tuesday, September 14 at 7pm for a FREE webinar with the Club Cowgirls gurus Shannon Pigott and Barbra Schulte. They will be teaching a methodology for reading cattle for showpen success. Be prepared for a fun, interactive one-hour learning session that will help you in your cow work and cutting. As the show season winds down, don't forget eligibility requirements for Year End Awards! Riders must attend at least 50% of the shows during the year to receive Year End prizes, so that means riders must compete in at least 5 shows in 2021. Those competing in fewer than 5 shows will still be in the standings but will not be eligible to win awards. We've got STS Ranchwear jackets, JW Brooks hats, Saddle House and Dennis Moreland tack and more for year end, so make sure you're eligible to receive awards!

We are deep into planning the Western Horseman Stock Horse World Show. There is a wealth of information on the World Show in this newsletter, so be sure to take a look. The tentative schedule is online. New in 2021 is a Welcome Party on Wednesday evening, and we're bringing back the FUN with the Fence Work Showcase, Dog Races and Youth Freestyle Reining. #### **RV AND TRUCK PARKING ETIQUETTE**

There have been a few problems at shows with RV parking, vehicles blocking spots, and other issues. Getting frustrated when you first arrive is not a good way to start a great weekend.

- Please make sure that you are in YOUR parking spot or stall.
   Double check all stall/RV numbers before you get situated. If you are in the wrong spot, you will have to move.
- When you park your truck, please consider if your vehicle might be impeding your neighbor backing in their RV spot.
- If you have a slide out, make sure your slide stays within your parking spot. If you extend into the neighbors spot, scoot over.
- If you have challenges parking your trailer, consider arriving early before the parking lot gets full.
- Please do not "edit" someone else's stall reservation. This causes a lot of issues.
- We prefer people to make their own stall and RV reservations.
   When you make reservations for multiple people, it is a challenge in the office.

# TQHA Partnership Set to Award \$20,000 to SHTX Members

Since 2018, SHTX has partnered with Texas Quarter Horse Association to provide incentives for Stock Horse of Texas members. TQHA works tirelessly for the betterment of the horse world in Texas, including representing the equine industry on legislative issues. The Texas Quarter Horse Foundation also supports

scholarships, equine research and charitable works within the industry.

Working closely with TQHA, Stock Horse of Texas applied for Texas HIEA (Horse Industry Escrow Account funds). HIEA is a trust account with money from sales tax on horse supplies and related items, and is managed



by the Texas legislature. The funds are earmarked for programs that grow and support the horse industry in Texas. With TQHA's help, SHTX was awarded two HIEA grants. The SHTX-TQHA Ride For the Cash Program will award \$10,000 to eligible SHTX members at the Year End Banquet. To be eligible, SHTX members must also be members of TQHA, and participate in the SHTX All Around at 6 or more shows.

The Texas Triple Threat Incentive will payout \$10,000 to horses competing at

# Kris Wilson's Legacy Rides On

It's always fun when things come "full circle." Dr. Kris Wilson was a former president of SHTX and long-serving Board Member. While Assistant Professor at Texas Tech, Kris founded the first ever collegiate ranch horse team. At the time he told a local reporter, "When I came to Tech I thought it would be good to have a traveling ranch horse team. Tech was the first team in the nation to do that." Kris outfitted a group of students in Texas Tech shirts and entered them in a SHTX show in Abilene. Today, close to 20 colleges and universities have followed Kris' model with ranch and stock horse teams.

Kris passed away in 2016, serving on the SHTX Board until his death. Kris is survived by his wife, Cara, son Grady and daughter Josey. They moved to Colorado with Cara's family after Kris' death.

This summer, the Wilson family spent the summer in Texas, and Cara, Josey and Grady came to a few SHTX clinics and shows. In Amarillo, Grady rode

named "Hawk," that is owned by one of

a buckskin gelding Kris' close friends,





Kim Lindsey. Kris knew Hawk well, and was never a fan of the gelding. He much preferred another buckskin gelding, Reno, also owned and shown by Kim Lindsey.

Hawk has been in the SHTX family for years....once as a mount for Kim's late son Zinn Lindsey, and



also with SHTX Secretary Kelsey Coon when she was a member of the Texas Tech Ranch Horse Team.

Hawk hadn't been at a SHTX show since 2013, but he picked up right where he left off. Grady spent a month working with Kim learning how to ride Hawk, and it paid off at the Palo Duro Gathering in Amarillo with the Reserve Champion Novice Youth buckle.

After Kim heard the results of the Amarillo show, she smiled and said, "I can just see Kris and Zinn sitting

> together in Heaven. Kris is shaking his head and saying I can't believe y'all put my kid on that horse!!! He's wondering why we didn't put him on 'the good one' (aka Reno). And Zinn is sitting there with him with that little sideways grin and saying he is the good one!!!"

Congratulations, Grady and welcome the to the SHTX Family. We're pretty certain your daddy and Zinn are still grinning in Heaven.

#### HISTORICAL CORNER: REMEMBERING ROGER

I'm fairly certain quite a few SHTX members know that three men share membership #1. Jack Brainard, noted horseman and author, and Dr. Doug Householder, retired Extension Horse Specialist, clinician and competitor are known to many members. The third member #1, Roger Blackmon, was more of a behind-the-scenes kind of guy and might not be as familiar to our membership. Roger died at the age of 83 on March 20 of this year.

Roger worked as a County Extension Agent in several counties around the state and was on the original SHTX Leadership Team. He had connections with the management at the Taylor County Expo Center in Abilene. It is my understanding that he and Vicki Hoggett were able to use the facilities as long as the event was held Tuesday through Thursday and enough was charged to clean up the place. What a bargain those late '90s clinics were at \$85 for a three-day clinic with Jack Brainard and other noted horsemen; it also included stalls for however many horses you could haul to Abilene! Roger, with his ever present pipe, was there to help move things along. When SHTX first began taking memberships, the meager \$10 dues were mailed to Roger who served as Acting Executive Director. He was also in large part responsible for organizing the first general membership meeting at the extension office in Stephenville in May 1998.

Anyone who knew Roger has a "Roger story." Mine occurred during a show in Graham at the Young County

Expo Center in 2006. The trail course was in a wooded area; Roger was the judge. The first obstacle was a gate, the second a drag. The rider before me and Freckles worked the gate just fine, but




when he picked up the drag rope, his horse went south in a hurry, straight for Roger and his scribe. The rider's hand was clamped to the rope like a vise; no amount of yelling could get him to drop the rope, and the live oak which had been providing shade for Roger and his scribe now served as cover! The guy finally did release the drag and declined to finish the course. A while after Freckles and I finished our work, which was fair, probably fifth or sixth, I went to the office to see how Mary Anne and Norma were doing and was greeted with, "What happened to you and Freckles?" Except for the gate, my scores were zeros. Roger's scribe had gotten so rattled that he got on the wrong line on the score sheet. B.F. talked to Roger, and I was given a re-ride. The practice run helped, and I placed second. Vicki had the idea of giving SHTX ball caps instead of ribbons so blue for first, red for second, etc. I still have that red cap. Thanks for that and so much more, Roger. Rest in peace.

#### HORSE SHOW TRACKER ENTRY SYSTEM

The Horse Show Tracker entry system is up and running. It will save all of your info (memberships, address, horse registration info, etc) for quick entering at future shows! It does take a few minutes to set up an account and add your exhibitor and horse information the first time. But after that, everything is saved for future shows.

Your first 3 shows, the Horse Show Tracker system is free. However, after that, you must join with a paid account. We hope you will see the benefit of a paid account on how fast you can enter / adjust and change entries for a show. On our end, your entries automatically populate in our computer system, where other types of entries have to be hand keyed in for every horse. However, you are always welcome to enter via email or PDF filler. Other associations are also using Horse Show Tracker and your account allows you to enter any show utilizing the system, not just SHTX shows.

\*\*\*SHTX will draw a winner for 1 free stall night at each show to a rider who uses Horse Show Tracker entry system. The free stall night can be used at a future SHTX show.
