

Heads Up Dog Owners!

We know many of you enjoy bringing your furry friends to horse shows as they are part of your family. However, recent events have led the SHTX Board of Directors to amend the "Dog Rule" in the 2021 Rule Book. At the last few shows, dogs have been a big problem. In fact, loose dogs got into show areas FOUR TIMES at the World Show. This not only infringes on competition but is a huge safety issue. Another big problem is owners not cleaning up after their dogs. This is completely unacceptable.

Because of this, the Board recently amended the Dog Rule and is committed to enforcing the rule.

GR-205.3 Dogs are not allowed closer than ten feet to any arena fence, horse exhibition area or horse practice/warm-up area. Dogs must be on an in-hand leash and managed by a competent handler.

Enforcement of this rule will take place per rule **GR-060 DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES** in the current rule book. Per this rule, **those not complying will be subject to disciplinary action including suspension and/or fines** by the Executive Committee for each offense.

This rule will be enforced with disciplinary action in 2021.

To be clear:

- You must hold on to the leash.
- You must have a responsible person tending to your dog which includes picking up after the dog and not letting the dog be a distraction to competition.
- No dogs are allowed in any riding area, including the warm up pen.

In short, enough is enough. There will be strict enforcement on this rule at every SHTX event. The only exception will be in the case of an organized dog-related event approved by the SHTX Board. SHTX is clarifying the requirements for managing dogs for the safety of its members.

We all love the dog races at the World Show, and we want that to continue. We also want you to enjoy the camaraderie you have with your pets. However, responsibility for your dogs is key. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.








Plan 4 Progress Incentive Challenge 2021




CHANGES IN THE SCRATCH POLICY FOR SHOWS & CLINICS

Previously, scratches/cancellations could be made without any financial penalty before the show started on Friday night. Our association has tried to remain flexible as we understand things happen and plans change. However in 2020, a large number of riders scratched within 24 hours of the start of a show. Cattle were already on their way or on site and SHTX had to pay for cattle on entries that were scratched. (At a few shows, there were 25-35+ scratches just before the show.) This turned into a large unrecoverable expense for the association.

Thus, starting in 2021, the SHTX Board has approved a new scratch policy for weekend events:

- All scratches must be received in the SHTX Office by Monday, the week of the show. Any scratches made after Monday will be charged the Cattle Fee and Office Charge. Riders who enter but do not show up and do not scratch will be charged the Cattle Fee and Office Charge.
- Once a rider has checked in and received their back number, no refunds are given for scratches once draws are posted or the show has started, whichever comes first.
- Clinic cancellations must be received by Wednesday at 6pm (week of clinic) in order to fill empty spots from the Wait List. SHTX will do our best to try and fill any cancellations. Cancellations after the Wednesday deadline will be refunded if the slot is filled. Clinic no-shows will be billed the clinic fee.

AQHA Rookie VRH Division Announced

AQHA recently announced the addition of Rookie Amateur and Rookie Youth versatility ranch horse classes. The Rookie classes will run concurrently with the Novice and Novice Youth SHTX divisions. Rookie exhibitors will box only in the cow work and will not drag in the trail.

AQHA also clarified there is a restriction of cross-entering across divisions. The same horse-and-rider combination may not cross-enter amateur, limited amateur and/or Rookie amateur at the same show, and the same goes for cross-entering youth, limited youth and/or Rookie youth at the same show.

Rookie Class Eligibility

For an exhibitor to be eligible in the amateur or youth rookie division, the exhibitor must have earned no more than ten (10) lifetime points in any breed association (including but not limited to AQHA, APHA, AQHA VRH All Around); or \$500 in a national organization (including but not limited to NCHA, NRCHA, NRHA, RHAA, NRSHA, NSBA) in any western performance discipline (including but not limited to western pleasure, working cow horse, reining, cutting, trail.) Accuracy of eligibility is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Eligibility is from January 1 - December 31.

SHTX Concurrent Classes

The Rookie division will run concurrent with the SHTX Novice/Novice Youth Divisions. However, you may notice that SHTX Intermediate riders may also be eligible for the AQHA Rookie VRH division. It is not possible to make those runs concurrent due to differences in the cow and trail rules. If you show in the SHTX Intermediate, you would need to make additional runs in the VRH Rookie to enter that class.

Keep in mind, to be a VRH All Around Entry, a rider must enter 1 cattle class, 1 non-cattle class and conformation. You do not have to enter all 6 VRH classes, so you would not have to make separate runs in every class.

AQHA does plan on offering the Rookie VRH divisions at the Championship Show in Guthrie, Oklahoma scheduled for June 2021. It will run concurrent with the NRSHA Novice division.

NRSHA & VRH Qualifying Period for 2022 March 1, 2021 to February 28, 2022

Both NRSHA and AQHA have waived qualifying for the championship shows scheduled for June 2021 due to the pandemic, but expect regular qualifying to resume for the 2022 Championships.

We lost a tough, brave cowgirl when Darlene Isbell Hicks of Hawley, Texas, died on July 10, 2011. She never rode a horse until after she married Thomas Hicks, but she soon loved to ride and show horses. She learned to team rope with her husband and also enjoyed wagon driving. Darlene was a member of Stock Horse of Texas Association, Texas Draft Horse Association and American Stock Horse Association. She was diagnosed with colon cancer in 2000. While fighting cancer, she showed in Stock Horse of Texas competitions on several



different horses. She won buckles, bronzes, a saddle and she was SHTX Reserve Champion Limited Non-Pro for 2010. One saying that gave Darlene encouragement during her battle was, "courage is being scared to death - but saddling up anyway."

In her honor, the Darlene Hicks Scholarship fund was established. This scholarship is awarded to a graduating high school senior. Applications are due February 1, and can be found on the SHTX website in the Scholarships section.

The Josie Coverdale Scholarship is dedicated to an Aggie team member


