# **Classes Offered:**

In all SHTX divisions – Cow Work, Reining, Stock Horse Trail & Stock Horse Pleasure. No AQHA or APHA classes will be offered. No Ranch Cutting at this show. All classes will follow the SHTX Rule Book. Rule Books are available at the show or online.

#### Paid Warm Ups:

- Thursday 2-7pm > Cow, Trail & Reining
- Friday > Cow & Trail only for a short time immediately following the show on Friday evening

Arenas (excluding trail) will be open for general riding at all times unless the ground is being prepared for the show.

- Cow Paid Practice \$50 for 3-1/2 minutes. Must be reserved online (will release the online sign up on Sept. 9 via email/website). If you reserve a Cow Paid Practice online, please mark "cow paid practice" on your entry form so that it can be included on your invoice. No cow paid practices will be available to sign up at the show.
- Trail Cash at the Gate \$25 per course (there will be 2 trail courses) for 10 minutes. Up to 4 horses at a time on the course. No horses will be allowed in the trail arenas without paying the paid practice fee. Trail arenas will be locked at all other times and available to walk (on foot only) 30 minutes prior to the start of the show each morning.
- Reining Cash at the Gate \$25 for 5 minutes alone in the main reining arena. The overflow reining arena (Horse Barn) is open anytime to all riders.

# **Stalls/RV Information:**

Grounds open at 2pm on Wednesday, October 23. All stalls & RVs are first come, first serve. Please bring a separate check for stalls/RVs. They will be paid separately from show checkin. If you are saving stalls/RV for someone, you must pay at check-in.

- Stalls \$30 (Grounds Fee \$15 if no stall)
- RVs \$35
- Shavings \$10 -- To expedite shavings delivery, all stalls will be pre-bedded with 3 bags of unopened shavings that must be paid for when you get your stall. No outside shavings allowed.
