WORLD SHOW STALL POLICY

The Expo Center has hundreds of brand new stalls and RV sites! The stalls are located in the New Livestock Barn and also in the CODA (Covered Outdoor Arena). More than 100 new RVs surround these two barns. Stalls and RVs will be chosen on a first-come, first serve basis.

You must pay for the stalls and RVs when you arrive. **IF YOU ARE SAVING STALLS/ RVS FOR SOMEONE, YOU MUST PAY FOR THEM AT THAT TIME**. We can't track "saved" stalls, so no stalls/RVs will be unlocked or saved unless paid for.

Please bring a separate check for stalls/ RVs. They will be paid for separately from show check-in.

The stall office will be open in the new Livestock Barn on Wednesday afternoon until 7pm, and Thursday 9am-7pm. If you plan to arrive after 7pm, please call 855-846-7468 to make arrangements. After 7pm, someone from the Expo Center will unlock your stalls. Bring your receipt to check-in and pay for stalls/RVs the following morning.

PAID PRACTICES

Paid practices will be handled differently than in years' past. **ALL cow paid practices MUST BE RESERVED IN ADVANCE ON THE ENTRY FORM**. These will be added to your show bill and paid for when you check in. No additional paid cow practices will be available at check-in.

• There will be an opportunity to sign up for specific cattle times via an online sign up sheet. A link to this will be available at stockhorsetexas.org. <u>You must reserve a cow on the entry form --</u> signing up for a time does NOT automaticaly reserve you a cow.

Trail & Reining paid practices will be **PAID IN CASH ONLY AT THE GATE**. No credit cards accepted. Sign ups are first come, first served at the gate.
