## SHOT NAMES NEW EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

After 20 years of membership and seven years as SHOT's Executive Director, Kim Lindsey has accepted the position of Director of Ranching Programs with AQHA. She is moving to Amarillo and is excited to help grow and manage the concept of a versatile stock horse nationwide. But just because she's changing jobs doesn't mean we won't see Kim at SHOT events. As part of her newly created position with AQHA, Kim will be at several shows working to further enhance opportunities for AQHA members with ranch and stock horses.

In early February, the SHOT Board of Directors voted to hire Jill Dunkel to replace Kim. Jill has worked with SHOT for the last year handling all the marketing, newsletters and advertising. Jill grew up in Amarillo and was active in the horse industry showing extensively as a youth. She received a Bachelor of Science from Texas A&M and was on the Texas A&M Horse Judging Team and Equestrian Team. She is the fifth generation to live on her family's ranch near Archer City and ran a freelance writing and graphic design business for the last 23 years. She is a volunteer leader with her local 4-H club, and her family has been active in the horse industry for decades, showing in SHOT, AQHA and 4-H.

Many of you know Jill and her family as the show managers of the Vernon SHOT show. She is excited to take the reins of SHOT and hopes to continue the association's family-friendly educational platform and tradition of hosting fun, well organized and enjoyable horse shows.

Jill is married to Doug (another staple at the Vernon show) and has three children: Ashton, a freshman at Texas A&M; Sidney, 17 and a junior in high school, and Blake, 14 and in the 8th grade.

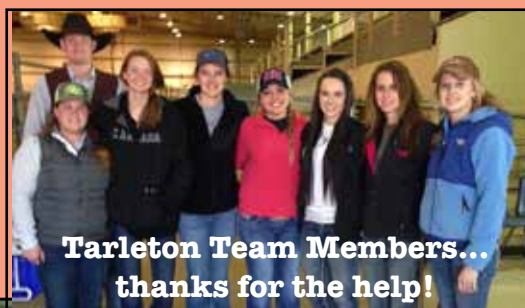
## SHOT Novice Clinic A HUGE SUCCESS!

The first SHOT Novice Horsemanship Clinic was very successful. The group worked with AQHA judges Allen and Bobbie Walton on a variety of skills. They practiced basic horsemanship skills such as collection, the basic walk, trot and lope. They practiced the pleasure course and then had the opportunity to "judge" each participant as they discussed form, gaits and transitions.

Next they practiced reining by working on circles, turns and stops. During a working lunch, the group visited with the Waltons about what they see as a judge. Each participant was given a copy of the 2016 AQHA Rulebook. Bobbie and Allen encouraged each rider to become very familiar with the rules and know how they are scored. The group ended the day working the flag, practicing on straight stops and keeping their eyes on the "cow."

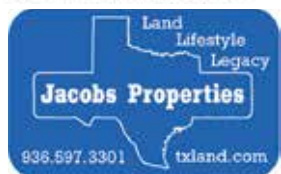

In her new role, Lindsey will be responsible for developing new programs to enhance and educate American Quarter Horse owners about the ranching division of the Association. She will also direct and coordinate Versatility Ranch Horse competitions in addition to the Zoetis AQHA Versatility Ranch Horse World Championships.

"We are excited about the future of AQHA ranching with Kim at the helm," said Pete Kyle, AQHA chief show officer. "We believe her strong background will bring a lot to the table when planning, directing and coordinating programs and events designed to build ownership and interest in ranching horses."

Employed most recently by Texas Tech University as the equestrian center director, Lindsey boasts a long history of involvement with American Quarter Horses and AQHA competition. She has also been the executive director of the Stock Horse of Texas Association since 2009 where she oversaw the activities of the more than 900 members along with competition coordination and budgeting.

Lindsey received her bachelor's degree from Eastern New Mexico University where she was a member of the rodeo team and a College National Finals Rodeo qualifier.

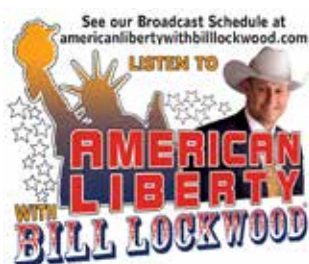

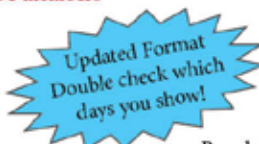
